This will be achieved through the combined efforts of the sponsors, the Kelrn personnel and the registered public benefit organisations that forms part of the Kelrn MTB Classic.

FRIDAY 25 OCTOBER

DIAMOND DASH

This race is the **first stage of the 100 miler** but can also be entered exclusively as **a race on its own**. It starts at 16:00 on Friday afternoon and should be finished at 18:30. This is more of a **fun ride**, mostly single track.

It will take riders through the diamond diggings, along the fence of a well know game farm while on the last stretch experiencing the Northern Cape sunset. It is part of a current route and will require low to average cycling skills.

Only participants that had entered in this race **exclusively**, will take part in the **diamond lucky draw**. The lucky winner will be determined by drone drop. Podium positions and prizes and medals will be bestowed. *A lucky diamond draw and fun lucky draws will be entertained.*





SATURDAY 26 OCTOBER

KELRN MTB CLASSICS | 1

THE KELRN MTB "I3 KM CLASSIC"

This is a current race on the Saturday morning and popular amongst **families**. Kids under 10 should be accompanied by an adult.

Podium finishes and prizes and medals will be bestowed on the qualifying participants.

It starts directly after the "35 km Classic" in the morning on Saturday 26 October 2024, 08:30 and cut off time is 12:00.

KELRN MTB CLASSICS | 2

THE KELRN MTB "35KM CLASSIC"

This is a current race and very popular amongst **average mountain bikers**, **above 12 years of age**, **adults**, **and masters**. It is not an easy route and requires skills and reasonable fitness levels. It's mostly single track.

Podium finishes and prizes and medals will be bestowed on the qualifying participants. It starts directly after the "67 km Classic" in the morning on Saturday 26 October 2024, 08:15 and cut off time is 12:00.


KELRN MTB CLASSICS | 3

THE KELRN MTB "67KM CLASSIC"

This race is the **second stage of the 100 miler** but can also be entered exclusively **as a race on its own**. Podium finishes and prizes and medals will be bestowed on the qualifying participants.

This is a current route and well known for its challenges and beautiful Northern Cape landscape. It's mostly single track. It requires skillful riders with reasonable fitness levels.

It starts at 08:00 in the morning on Saturday 26 October 2024 and cut off time is 12:00.

FUN RUN


The Kelrn Fun Run is a casual trail running event stretching over 5.3Km. The track will consist of a mixture of Jeep track, single track and gravel road.

THE KELRN MTB 1000 MILER


Saturday morning 26 October 2024 | Kelrn MTB Classic 67 km. This is a route well known for it challenges and demands more experienced riders.
